Colossians 1:15-20 NLT Christ is Supreme ¹⁵ Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. He existed before anything was created and is supreme over all creation, for through him God created everything in the heavenly realms and on earth. He made the things we can see and the things we can't see such as thrones, kingdoms, rulers, and authorities in the unseen world. Everything was created through him and for him. ¹⁷ He existed before anything else, and he holds all creation together. 18 Christ is also the head of the church, which is his body. He is the beginning, supreme over all who rise from the dead. So he is first in everything. ¹⁹ For God in all his fullness was pleased to live in Christ, 20 and through him God reconciled everything to himself. He made peace with everything in heaven and on earth by means of Christ's blood on the cross. RESPONSE: The Word of God, for the people of God. *Thanks be to God!*

The body, glorified

"I believe in ... the resurrection of the body," we confess in the Apostles' Creed. Yet often we speak of death of the *body*, reassuring ourselves and others that the person's *soul* is in heaven with God. The body/soul split is rooted in ancient Greek understanding, not Christian teaching. God chose to take on the physical body as the person Jesus, and Paul uses that very image to describe the Church.

Author Flannery O'Connor reflects on this wonder in *The Habit of Being*: "For me it is the virgin birth, the Incarnation, the resurrection which are the true laws of the flesh and the physical. Death, decay, destruction are the suspension of these laws. I am always astonished at the emphasis the Church puts on the body. It is not the soul she says that will rise but the body, glorified."
