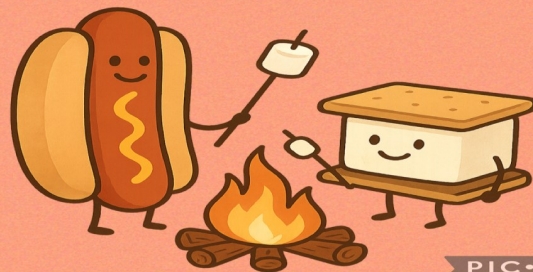

And sure enough, God answered my prayer! On the eighth time round the block, there it was!



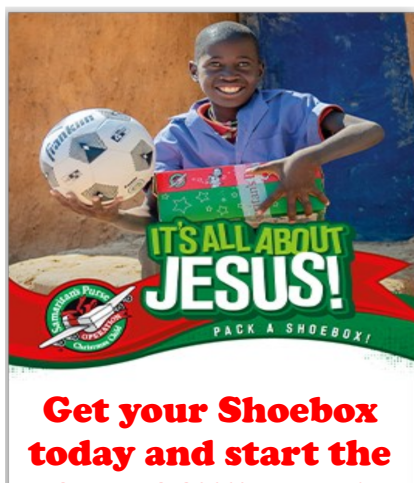
