

Some may have wondered if senility had taken over the old teacher's mind. The bishop, however, explained that Dr. Henry had called him before the service and had told him that he had read Jesus' words to the effect that "unless ... you become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 18:3). The bishop went on to relate that Dr. Henry said he wanted to make sure he got into the kingdom of heaven, so he was becoming like the children that morning. Everyone understood. Madge smiled with approval. And I? Well, I was left in wonderment having been challenged by the oldest "kid" in our church. —Charles Ferrell


